Title: Low-Impact Recreational Use of Marginal Lands

1.0. Purpose/Background

This policy provides a structured approach for the issuance of permits allowing low-impact recreational use of municipally owned marginal lands. The intent is to:

- Encourage community engagement and responsible land stewardship.
- Ensure minimum maintenance of unused lands at no cost to the municipality.
- Preserve the ecological integrity and future utility of municipal lands.

2.0. Scope

This policy applies to all municipally owned lands that:

- Are not currently designated for development, infrastructure, or other municipal purposes.
- Are deemed suitable for temporary, non-commercial, low-impact recreational use.

3.0. Definitions

- Marginal Lands: Lands owned by the municipality that are not actively used or maintained and have no immediate planned use.
- Low-Impact Recreational Use: Activities that do not involve permanent structures, excavation, or significant alteration of the land. Examples include:

Walking trails

Birdwatching

Temporary community gardens (no permanent beds or fencing)

Nature observation

Educational or cultural activities

4.0. Eligibility

Permits may be issued to:

- Individual residents of the municipality
- Community groups or associations

- Non-profit organizations
- Applicants must be in good standing with the municipality and demonstrate the capacity to maintain the land responsibly.

5.0. Application Process

Applicants must submit a written application including:

- Contact information
- Description of proposed use
- Duration of use
- Site plan or map (if applicable)
- Maintenance plan
- Acknowledgment of terms and conditions

Applications will be reviewed by municipal staff, and permits will be issued at the discretion of the municipality via Council resolution.

6.0. Terms and conditions

- No Permanent Alterations: No buildings, fences, grading, or other permanent modifications are allowed.
- *Maintenance*: The permit holder is responsible for keeping the area clean, safe, and free of debris or hazards.
- Access: The municipality retains the right to access the land at any time without prior notice.
- Revocability: Permits may be revoked at any time, for any reason, without compensation.
- Restoration: Upon revocation or expiration, the permit holder must restore the land to its original condition within 30 days or as otherwise specified.
- *Insurance:* The municipality may require proof of liability insurance depending on the nature of the use.
- Signage: No signage is permitted without prior written approval.

7.0. Environmental and Cultural Considerations

- Activities must not disturb wildlife, vegetation, or natural water courses.

8.0. Monitoring and Compliance

- Municipal staff may inspect the site at any time.
- Non-compliance may result in immediate revocation of the permit and potential penalties.
- Repeat violations may disqualify individuals or groups from future permits.

9.0. Liability

- The permit holder assumes all risks associated with the use of the land.
- The municipality is not liable for any injury, loss, or damage resulting from the permitted use.

- Insurance: Insurance requirements will be determined on a case-by-case basis depending on the intended use.
- Signage: No signage may be installed without prior written approval.
- Liability: The permit holder assumes all risks and liabilities associated with the use of the land. The municipality is not liable for any injury, loss, or damage.
