## THE HERRIOT BLOCK

William Herriot had this block built. It opened Friday, February 9, 1905. There were apartments on the second floor and many businesses on the ground floor. At one time there was a Drugstore and Doctor's Offices on the east end of the Block. On Sunday, December 11, 1966 a fire broke out and consumed most of the building. The following businesses were lost: Manitoba Liquor Commission, Tomlinson's Food Land, Jacobson Photo Studio, Glenwood-Souris Regional Library and Souris Dry Cleaners. As well, 11 people on the upper floor lost their homes. Some of the space was rebuilt, minus the top floor and today there are apartments on the west side, and two businesses facing Crescent Avenue: Ideanna's, and 49 degrees.
