

THE PLUM MUSEUM AND VISITOR CENTRE

The Plum is the original chancel for St. Luke's Anglican Church. It was originally built in 1883 and is Souris' oldest remaining public building. It was decommissioned in 1989 and moved to its current location, where it was restored to its original Victorian colours of plum and chocolate brown.
